WHAT DO I NEED TO STUDY EDUCATION?

A bachelor's degree or approved 360 credit diploma at NQF 6. The prior qualification must provide a broad knowledge base adequate for teaching subjects i.e. English, Afrikaans & an indigenous language (e.g. isiXhosa) and two primary school teaching subjects.

Holders of focused qualifications that do not have specialisations in primary school teaching subjects can register simultaneously for BA subjects.

BA teaching subjects which are offered at Cornerstone Institute are: psychology, counselling, philosophy, sociology, leadership, theology, biblical studies (Life Skills), research methods and statistics (Mathematics/Numeracy)

Minimum two years part-time

Work-intergrated Learning (To be completed in South Africa)

Study Praxis / Classroom Management

Teaching Practice (in 3 different schools)
