### WHAT DO I NEED TO STUDY PSYCHOLOGY

### **Undergraduate Studies**

(admission requirements):

With a Grade 12 Bachelors Pass, you can study a BA Degree (Psychology and Counselling Majors) and

BTh Psychology Degree (Psychology Major)

Duration: 3 years full-time or 7 years part-time studies.

With Grade 12 Diploma Pass, you can study **Higher Certificate in Community** 

**Counselling**, which could count towards a degree upon completion.

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

**Postgraduate Studies** (after you complete your degree):

You need a minimum of 65% at level 3. Psychology for a BA Psychology Honours Degree (Academic)

4th year of study.

Duration: 1 year full-time & 2 years part-time. (130 Credits)

BA Psychology Honours Degree (B.Psych Equivalent-Registered Counsellor Professional Training) Duration of 1 year and 6 months full-time programme (140 Credits)

Year 1: 140 credits and 6 modules Year 2: 6 month practicum placement
